
How to Work with My Wishlist Fabrics

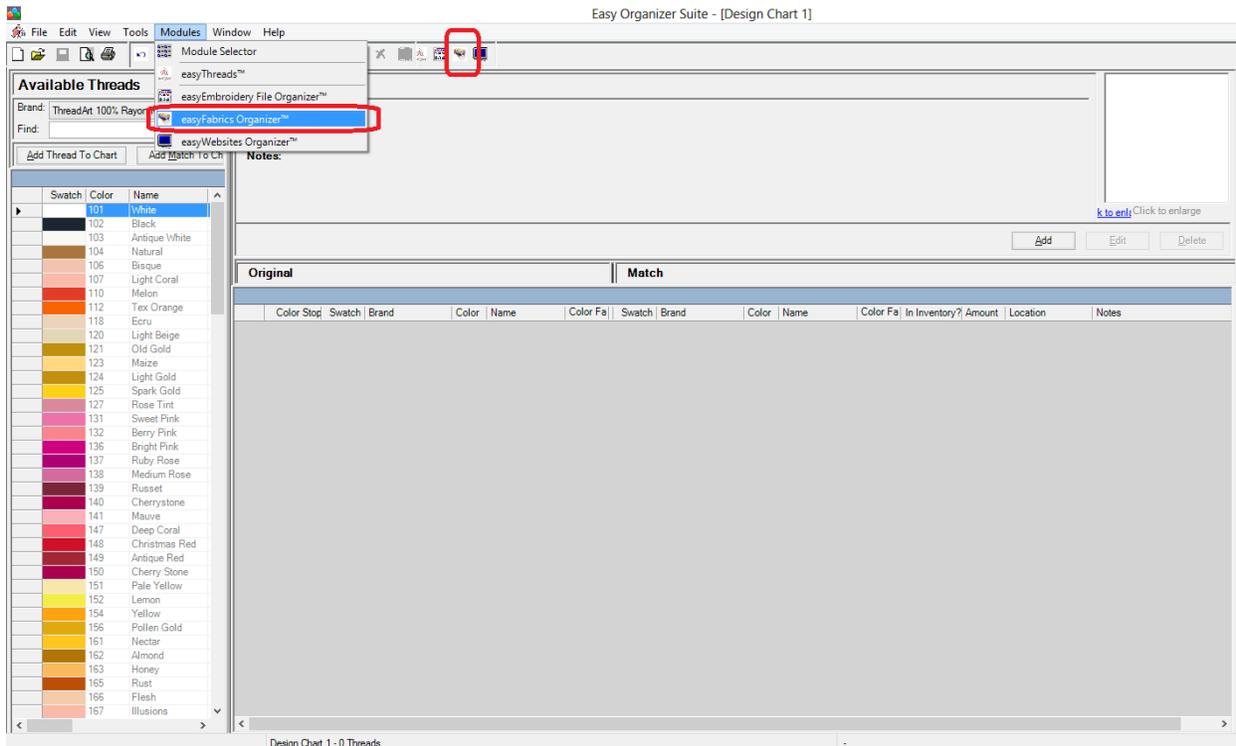
This lesson will show you how to work with My Wishlist Fabrics, and how to add, edit and delete My Wishlist Fabrics lists and fabrics.

Opening My Wishlist Fabrics


1. To begin, open **Easy Organizer Suite™** and select the **easyFabrics Organizer™** Module from the Module Selector.




2. If you are in another module, select Modules → easyFabrics Organizer™ from the menu, or you can click on the **easyFabrics Organizer™** icon in the toolbar.



- To see My Wishlist Fabrics, select the View → View My Wishlist Fabrics menu item. This will open a chart that will display all the fabrics in the first My Wishlist Fabrics list.




- The My Wishlist Fabrics chart will open.




Add a New Wish List

5. Click on the Add button to add a new wish list.




6. The Add Wish List form will open.



For this lesson, we'll enter this information in the Add Wish List form:

Name: My First Fabric Wish List


Notes: These are a few fabrics that I am hoping to get.



7. Let's add a picture to the new wish list. Click on the Picture button to open the Add/Edit Picture form.




8. The Add/Edit Picture form will open. Click on the Browse... button to find an image.




9. The Open Image window will appear. Select an image and click on the Open button.



10. The image you selected will be displayed. Click on the OK button to accept this image.




11. The Add/Edit Picture form will close. Click on the OK button to add this new wish list.

12. The My Wish List Chart will now have the new wish list added to the Wish List dropdown, and it will be selected. There will not be any fabrics in it yet.



Add a Fabric to My Wishlist Fabrics chart

1. To add a fabric that is displayed in the My Wish List chart, find a fabric in the Available Fabrics tree by expanding the tree. Select a fabric by clicking on it. Then drag it to the grey area where the fabrics are displayed in the My Wish List chart. Let go of the left mouse button to drop the fabric into the wish list.

For this lesson, let's expand Northcott, then Artisan Spirit, then Falling Leaves, then Autumn Harvest in the Available Fabrics tree. Click on the first fabric, 5067-24 and drag it to the grey area of the My First Fabric Wish List. Let go of the left mouse button to drop the fabric into the wish list.

The Add/Edit My Wishlist Fabric form will open. The Manufacturer, Line and Fabric will already be selected. You can now enter the Amount, Measurement, PreCut, Rating and Notes for the fabric in your Wish List.




3. You will now see the fabric added to the new Wish List.




Click on the Save icon in the toolbar to save the changes.

Editing a Fabric in a Wish List

1. To edit the details of a fabric in a wish list, select the fabric by clicking on it.



2. Right click and select Edit Fabric.



3. The Add/Edit My Wishlist Fabric form will open with the information you previously entered in it.



4. Although you can't see any of the changes in the My Wish List Fabrics chart, if you right click and select Edit Fabric again, you will see the changes in the form.


Click on the Save icon in the toolbar to save your changes.

5. To delete a fabric from a wish list, select the fabric by clicking on it.




6. Right click and select Delete Fabric.



- The system will ask you if you are sure, and if so, click on the Yes button to delete the Fabric. Otherwise, click on the No button.




- If you selected Yes, then you will no longer see the fabric in the My Wish List pane.




Editing a Wish List

1. To edit a wish list, click on the Edit button.



2. The Edit Wish List form will open.




For this lesson, we'll enter this information in the Edit Wish List form:


Name: My First Cool Fabric Wish List

Click on the OK button to accept your changes.




3. You will see the wish list in the drop down as well as the title to the form has changed.



Deleting a Wish List


1. To delete a wish list, select the wish list in the wish list drop down and click on the Delete button.



2. The system will ask you if you are sure, and if so, click on the Yes button to delete the Fabric. Otherwise, click on the No button.



3. If you selected Yes, then you will no longer see the wish list in the My Wish List pane.



Click on the Save icon in the toolbar to save your changes.
